



GUIDE TO COMPLETING THE RENUNCIATION FORM

PLR is an intellectual property right, which can be given away, sold, or transferred on death. This form may be used to remove your books from the Register either temporarily or permanently.

If the current owner has died, please complete all section of the form except Section B.

If you are the current owner and you are giving away or selling your PLR, please complete all section of the form except Section C.

The Public Lending Right Act 1979 (s.1(7)(d)) allows for the right "to be renounced (either in whole or in part, and either temporarily or for all time) on notice being given to the Registrar to that effect".
